# **Core Skills Analysis**

#### **Science**

- The 5-year-old student learns about the concept of suction and how vacuum cleaners work to suck in dirt and dust.
- By observing the process of vacuuming, the student understands the role of air pressure in creating suction for cleaning.
- Through hands-on experience, the student grasps the idea of particles being lifted and captured by the vacuum's mechanism.
- The child may develop an interest in exploring different surfaces and textures to see how well the vacuum cleaner can clean them.

### Math

- Counting becomes a part of the activity as the student may count the number of times they move the vacuum over a specific area.

#### Life Skills

- The child learns responsibility by taking part in a household chore and contributing to the cleanliness of the environment.
- Time management skills may be fostered as the student learns to allocate time for vacuuming as part of a routine.
- Safety awareness can be promoted by teaching the child to handle the vacuum cleaner appropriately and use it in a safe manner.
- Attention to detail is developed as the student focuses on cleaning specific areas and ensuring thoroughness in the task.

## **Tips**

To further enhance the learning experience related to vacuuming, consider incorporating games like 'Follow the Clean Trail' where the child can create patterns while vacuuming. Encourage exploration by using the vacuum on different materials like carpets, tiles, and rugs to see how they affect the cleaning process. Additionally, involve the child in simple maintenance tasks of the vacuum cleaner to teach care and learn how the machine functions.
