Life Skills

- Understanding the importance of organization by selecting and arranging items for the trip.
- Developing decision-making skills through choosing what to pack based on the trip's duration and activities.
- Recognizing the concept of personal responsibility by taking ownership of her own belongings.
- Practicing patience and problem-solving by managing limited space in the suitcase.

Communication

- Enhancing expressive language skills by discussing what to pack and why certain items are necessary.
- Learning to ask for help or clarification when uncertain about what to bring.

- Engaging in basic addition and subtraction when evaluating if the suitcase is too full or has enough room for additional items.

Tips

To further explore and improve, consider involving the child in related activities such as planning a detailed itinerary for the trip, discussing different types of luggage and their functions, or exploring the weather of the travel destination which could help her make better packing choices. Encouraging her to use a checklist can also aid in learning organization and prioritization skills.
