Science

- The child learns about the concept of hiding and revealing objects as they wrap and unwrap the toys in newspaper.
- They understand the concept of texture as they feel and touch the newspaper while wrapping and unwrapping the toys.
- The child explores cause and effect as they discover that wrapping the toys makes them disappear from sight, and unwrapping them reveals the toys again.
- They develop their fine motor skills as they manipulate the newspaper to wrap and unwrap the toys.

Encourage the child to experiment with different types of materials for wrapping the toys, such as tissue paper or fabric. This will allow them to explore different textures and expand their understanding of materials.
