Additionally, consider incorporating simple crafts related to the Bible verses they learn, such as decorating a picture frame for their whiteboard. Encourage them to share their favorite verse with family members each week to foster open discussions about their faith and personal growth. You could also include group activities that incorporate role-playing scenarios based on the narratives from the Bible to help them relate these concepts to their everyday lives.
