Parents can encourage the child to create a Thanksgiving journal, documenting thoughts on each character's contribution, which would intertwine creative writing with social studies. Additionally, exploring math through cooking together, such as adjusting a recipe, could make practical use of measurements and fractions while relating back to the movie's themes.
