Core Skills Analysis

Mathematics

- The student practiced basic addition and subtraction skills by calculating the attack points of Pokémon cards and managing health points during battles.

Tips

To enhance further exploration and improvement, I suggest the parent or teacher encourage Child to engage in structured tournaments or casual play sessions with peers to reinforce the concepts of strategy and social interaction. They can also assist Child in creating a custom Pokédex or writing short stories about their Pokémon, integrating more literacy aspects into play. Introducing card trade sessions can also enhance social skills and negotiation capabilities, as well as encourage creativity in deck-building.
