For social studies, stimulating conversations about the dynamics she observes and fostering critical thinking about family structures and diversity can deepen her understanding. A potential activity could be to have Azure create a presentation on how her Sims' life reflects societal issues or trends, linking gameplay to real-world scenarios.
