Art

Tips

This deepens narrative skills and reinforces sequencing and self-expression. Explore star-themed songs and rhythmic chants that incorporate the themes of dreams to further integrate music and language learning. Consider introducing simple cultural stories about stars from around the world to expand historical and cultural awareness. Finally, extend the art activity by using varied materials like fabrics or recyclable items to inspire tactile creativity and environmental awareness.
