Introduce games or puzzles that use percentages, such as calculating discounts during a mock sale, to make abstract concepts more tangible. Additionally, time-based challenges with varied math operations can boost both accuracy and speed, fostering confidence. This multi-faceted approach caters to practical learning and cognitive development.
