

Core Skills Analysis

Geography and Cultural Studies

- Zenia learned about the unique desert environment of Marrakesh, including its barren landscape and the adaptations of animals like camels that thrive there.
- She explored the architectural styles local to the region, including the design and function of Riads and old desert buildings that blend with the red/orange sand colors and provide protection from the harsh climate.
- Her experience in the Medina and local markets helped her understand the cultural significance of trade, bartering, and the traditional dress code influenced by Muslim customs.
- Zenia developed a deeper appreciation for Moroccan and Berber musical traditions by observing live performances and discovering their role in cultural identity.

Science and Environmental Studies

- At the Argan oil cooperative, Zenia learned the biological process of extracting oil from Argan seeds, distinguishing edible oil from cosmetic products, and saw traditional grinding techniques.
- She observed firsthand the protective adaptations of desert animals such as camels' large hooves for ground control and their humps which store fat as an energy reserve.
- Zenia gained practical knowledge about natural remedies and herbal medicine, including how local herbs and Moroccan white clay are used to treat skin conditions like eczema and acne.
- She experienced the importance of wearing protective clothing and gear to shield against environmental challenges like sun and sand during desert travel and quad biking.

Food and Cultural Culinary Arts

- Tasting local Moroccan cuisine like chicken tagine, couscous, peppermint sweet tea, and local peanut butter gave Zenia insight into regional food customs and cooking techniques.
- She learned how local ingredients and cooking methods are deeply connected to cultural practices and environmental conditions.
- Sampling diverse products like edible Argan oil and traditional handmade skincare items broadened her understanding of sustainable resource use in food and body care.
- Her exposure to natural food production methods and local dietary customs encouraged cross-cultural culinary awareness and appreciation.

Tips

To further enrich Zenia's understanding, encourage her to research the cultural history and significance of Morocco's Berber people, perhaps through documentaries or interviews with Moroccan families. A hands-on project could involve making a simple Moroccan-style recipe like couscous or a tagine dish at home to understand the cooking process physically. For science, exploring how other desert animals or plants have adapted to harsh environments can expand her knowledge of biology and ecology. Lastly, creating a photo journal or scrapbook of her trip, including sketches or write-ups about the architecture, folk music, and market bartering experiences, can deepen reflection and integrate knowledge across disciplines.
