# Tips

To deepen understanding of strategy and problem-solving, encourage the student to keep a gameplay journal where they record different strategies tried, outcomes, and lessons learned. To explore mythology further, suggest researching one or two Greek gods featured in the game and creating a presentation or creative project about their myths. Integrate art by designing their own character or weapon inspired by the game's themes, encouraging creative expression. Finally, analyzing the game's storyline and its narrative choices can lead to writing alternative endings or story expansions, developing writing and critical analysis skills.
