- Developed reading skills by reading the script of the Broadway musical Newsies.
- Improved vocabulary by encountering new words and phrases in the script.
- Enhanced comprehension skills by analyzing the plot, characters, and themes of the musical.
- Strengthened writing skills by writing a review or analysis of the musical.
- Expanded listening skills by listening to the original cast recording of Newsies.
- Practiced speaking skills by discussing the musical with peers or family members.
- Explored the historical context of the musical, improving knowledge of history and social studies.
- Developed critical thinking skills by evaluating the performances and production elements of Newsies.
- Enhanced creativity by imagining and creating alternative endings or scenes for the musical.

Continued development related to the activity can be achieved by:

- Exploring other Broadway musicals and analyzing their scripts, music, and performances.
- Participating in or organizing a school or community theater production.
- Writing original scripts or stories inspired by the themes or style of Newsies.
- Researching the historical events depicted in Newsies and writing a report or essay on the topic.
- Attending live theater performances and discussing them with others.
