

## Art

- The child learned about color mixing by observing how the batter changes from a pale color to a golden brown when cooked.
- They practiced fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination by pouring the batter onto the pan and flipping the pancakes.
- They could exercise creativity by decorating the pancakes with different toppings or creating pancake shapes using a squeeze bottle.
- They might have explored the concept of symmetry by attempting to make the pancake shapes symmetrical.

## Math

- The child practiced measuring ingredients, such as flour and milk, using measuring cups and spoons.
- They learned about fractions by following a recipe that required specific measurements, such as 1/2 cup of milk or 1/4 teaspoon of baking powder.
- They could understand the concept of multiplication by doubling the recipe to make more pancakes.
- They might have explored the concept of time and sequencing by following the cooking steps and monitoring the cooking time.

## Science

- The child learned about the reaction between baking powder/soda and heat, which causes the pancakes to rise and become fluffy.

They can also practice their measuring skills by adjusting the recipe quantities or trying to make mini or giant pancakes. Additionally, they can create their own pancake art by using food coloring or different shapes.
