Activity: "Did a Dinosaur Chart"

History

- The child learned about different types of dinosaurs and their characteristics.
- They learned about the timeline of dinosaur existence and when they became extinct.
- The child discovered how dinosaurs lived and what they ate.
- They gained knowledge about dinosaur habitats and the different environments they lived in.

Science

- The child learned about the physical features and adaptations of dinosaurs.
- They explored the concept of fossils and how they provide evidence of dinosaur existence.
- They learned about the process of fossilization and how fossils are formed.
- The child gained an understanding of how scientists study dinosaurs and make discoveries about them.
