- The child learned about character traits through the main character, Pig the pug, who is selfish and greedy.
- The child practiced making predictions by guessing what Pig might do next based on his personality traits.

- The child improved their reading comprehension by summarizing the main events of the story.

For continued development, encourage the child to write their own story featuring a different animal with a unique personality. They can use their imagination to create exciting adventures for their character.
