Math

- The child learned how to research and gather information on the costs of peanut butter and jelly sandwiches.
- They practiced using addition and subtraction to calculate the total cost of ingredients.
- They learned about budgeting and comparing prices to find the best deals on peanut butter and jelly.
- The activity allowed them to apply real-life math skills in understanding the value of money and making informed purchasing decisions.

Continued development can involve expanding the activity to compare the costs of different brands or types of peanut butter and jelly, and calculating the cost per serving or per sandwich.
