Science

- The child learned about the water cycle and how water evaporates from the Earth's surface and condenses to form clouds.
- They learned about the different layers of the Earth, including the crust, mantle, and core.
- The child gained an understanding of the solar system and the order of the planets from the Sun.
- They learned about different animals and their habitats, including the rainforest and the ocean.

For continued development related to the activity, encourage the child to explore more about the topics covered in the Magic schoolbus episode. They can conduct simple experiments at home to observe evaporation and condensation, create models of the Earth's layers using clay or playdough, research more about the planets and create a solar system model, or learn about different animals and their habitats through books or online resources.
