- The child has learned to identify and recognize the numbers on a ten-sided die.
- They have practiced counting and adding numbers up to 20.
- They have developed an understanding of basic probability by rolling dice and observing the different outcomes.
- The activity has reinforced the concept of addition and the idea of combining two numbers to get a sum.

For continued development, you can encourage the child to explore different variations of dice games, such as rolling three dice and adding them or rolling two dice and subtracting one number from the other. This will provide them with more opportunities to practice addition and subtraction skills while having fun.
