Math

- The child practiced counting and number recognition by collecting dots in the game.
- They learned about addition and subtraction as they gained or lost lives in the game.
- Understanding of patterns was developed while navigating through the maze.
- The concept of time was reinforced as the child had to complete levels before the time ran out.

Physical Education

- The child engaged in physical activity by using the keyboard or controller to control Pac-Man's movements.
- Hand-eye coordination was improved as the child maneuvered Pac-Man through the maze.
- Reaction time was enhanced as the child had to quickly evade or capture the ghosts.
- The child practiced spatial awareness as they planned Pac-Man's route to avoid obstacles.

Science
