## **Physical Education**

- The child learned strategic thinking and problem-solving skills by planning their moves and anticipating their opponent's moves in the game.
- They developed hand-eye coordination and motor skills by placing their game pieces accurately into the slots on the board.
- Connect 4 also helped improve their concentration and focus as they had to pay attention to the game board and their opponent's moves.
- The activity promoted social interaction and teamwork as the child played against another person, learning sportsmanship and fair play.
