Math

- The child learned how to count in 2s on a number grid.
- They practiced identifying even numbers while counting in 2s.
- The activity helped reinforce the concept of skip counting.
- The child gained a better understanding of number patterns.

For continued development, encourage the child to explore other skip counting patterns, such as counting in 3s or 5s. They can also try counting backwards in 2s or practicing skip counting with larger numbers.
