## **English Language Arts**

- The child learned about the importance of using bookmarks to keep track of the last-read page in a book.
- They practiced using descriptive language to write about their favorite book or character on the bookmark.
- The activity encouraged the child to engage with different genres of literature, as they chose books to create bookmarks for.
- They practiced summarizing the main events or themes of a book, as they reflected on what to include on the bookmark.

For continued development, the child could create bookmarks for specific genres, such as mystery or fantasy, and write brief summaries of books within those genres. They could also explore creating bookmarks that include quotes from the books they are reading, enhancing their understanding of literary elements such as theme and character development.
