

Art

- The child can learn about color mixing and contrast as they aim to shoot penguins against different backgrounds.
- They can explore creativity and design as they navigate through the visual elements of the game.
- They can develop an understanding of movement and dynamics through the animation of the penguins and their flight path.
- The game can inspire imaginative drawing or painting of penguin characters and their environment.

English Language Arts

- Reading comprehension can be enhanced through following instructions and storylines within the game.
- Spelling and vocabulary can be reinforced through game instructions and any in-game text.
- Storytelling and creative writing can be encouraged by asking the child to create their own story about the penguins in the game.

Music
