Math

- The child practices critical thinking and strategy as they plan their moves to win the game.
- By counting and sorting the colored discs, the child reinforces their understanding of numbers and basic arithmetic.
- They develop spatial awareness and learn about patterns and symmetry as they try to line up their colored discs in a row.
- The game helps the child understand the concepts of horizontal, vertical, and diagonal lines as they aim to connect four of their discs in a row.

Encourage the child to create their own version of the game using different materials and markers. They can also practice addition and subtraction by assigning point values to the discs and keeping score. Additionally, they can explore the concept of probability by analyzing the likelihood of certain outcomes based on the game board's current state.
