Social Studies

- The student learned about the structure of feudalism through the pyramid diagram, understanding the levels of society and the relationships between them.
- They gained insight into the roles and responsibilities of each social class within the feudal system, including the king, nobles, knights, and peasants.
- By studying the feudalism pyramid, the student grasped the idea of hierarchy and the distribution of power and resources in medieval society.

After completing the activity, students can further explore the concept of feudalism through roleplaying exercises, where they take on the roles of different members of society and act out their daily interactions. They can also delve into the historical context of feudalism through reading historical fiction set in the medieval period or by researching primary sources from the time.
