Math

- The Candy Land game helps students in understanding the concept of counting and number recognition as they move their game pieces along the board.
- Players engage in simple addition and subtraction as they pick cards and move their pieces forward or backward accordingly.
- The game also introduces the concept of probability as players depend on chance to draw colored cards to advance through the board.
- Through the game, students develop an understanding of patterns and sequencing as they navigate through the different colored spaces on the board.

Continued development can involve creating homemade math games using the same concept as Candy Land, such as a number recognition scavenger hunt where students find and match numbered items throughout the house or yard.
