

**Curriculum Day 1, Time Required:** 1 hour

**Topic Name:** Introduction to Narrative Writing

**Lesson Plan Description:** Understand the elements of a narrative (setting, characters, plot, conflict, and resolution). Read a short story and identify these elements. Discuss the importance of storytelling techniques.

**Worksheet Description:** Fill-in-the-blank worksheet identifying narrative elements in a provided short story. Short writing prompt to create a story outline.

**Quiz Description:** Multiple-choice quiz on parts of a narrative and terms used in storytelling.

**Lesson Plan Description:** Use the narrative writing structure and vocabulary skills to write a short creative story. Plan, draft, revise, and edit.

**Worksheet Description:** Planning template for story (outline characters, setting, plot). Drafting space with revision checklist.

**Quiz Description:** Peer editing checklist and self-assessment questions on writing skills.

**Subject Explorer:** "Composed and revised a creative short story demonstrating learned narrative skills."
