Moreover, 2nd graders can also explore **prepositions**. Prepositions are words that show the relationship between a noun or pronoun and other words in a sentence. Some common prepositions include 'on,' 'under,' and 'in.' Learning prepositions can help you understand where things are located!

Lastly, you can have fun with **punctuation marks**. Punctuation marks like periods, question marks, and exclamation points help you understand the tone of a sentence. Periods are used for statements, question marks are for questions, and exclamation points show excitement!
