

# Do Christians Wear Special Clothes?

Short answer: Most Christians do not have to wear special clothes all the time. But some people wear special clothes for church services, ceremonies, or because of their job or community.

## Why and when do Christians wear special clothes?

- **For worship or ceremonies:** People often dress nicer for church, called their 'Sunday best.'

- **Catholic and Orthodox priests:** Wear robes called cassocks or albs, and special outer garments called chasubles or phelonions during Mass. Bishops wear a pointed hat called a mitre. These clothes show they are leading the service.
- **Protestant pastors:** Some wear robes or a simple stole; others wear ordinary clothes depending on their church.
- **Monks and nuns:** Often wear a habit, which is a simple uniform that shows they are part of a religious community.
- **Amish and some Mennonite people:** Wear plain, modest clothes every day and women often wear head coverings.
- **Head coverings:** In some churches women wear veils or scarves in church. This is common in a few traditions, but not all.
- **Baptism clothes:** Babies or adults may wear a white gown to show being welcomed into the church.

## What does this mean for you?

- You might see lots of different clothes depending on the church you visit.
- Most Christians will be in regular clothes or their Sunday best, not special uniforms.
- If you go to a church event and you are unsure what to wear, it is fine to ask someone from the church.
