

Hello! Here are 10 words you can use to describe mountains

Each word has a short, easy meaning and an example sentence so you can practice.

1. **Tall** – very high. Example: The tall mountain reached up into the clouds.
2. **Huge** – very, very big. Example: The huge mountain looked like a giant's house.
3. **Rocky** – full of rocks. Example: We walked on a rocky path up the mountain.
4. **Snowy** – covered with snow. Example: The snowy peak was white and bright.
5. **Steep** – very slanted or hard to climb. Example: The steep trail made my legs tired.
6. **Green** – full of trees and grass. Example: The green mountain had lots of pine trees.
7. **Jagged** – pointy and uneven. Example: The jagged rocks looked like teeth.
8. **Misty** – covered in light clouds or fog. Example: The misty mountain looked soft and dreamy.
9. **Peaceful** – quiet and calm. Example: We sat on the mountain and felt peaceful.
10. **Mighty** – strong and powerful. Example: The mighty mountain stood guard over the valley.

Step-by-step fun activity

1. Pick a picture of a mountain or look outside.
2. Choose 3 words from the list that match what you see.
3. Write a short sentence using one of the words (try the example as a start).
4. Draw the mountain and color it. Label it with the 3 words you picked.
5. Show your drawing to a friend or teacher and say your sentence out loud.
