

Hello! An adjective is a word that describes something. Here are 7 kid-friendly words a 6-year-old can use to describe the ocean. Read each word, its short meaning, and a little example sentence.

1. **Big** — The ocean is very, very large. Example: "The ocean is big."
2. **Blue** — The water can look blue. Example: "The ocean is blue."
3. **Wavy** — The ocean makes waves that go up and down. Example: "The ocean is wavy today."
4. **Sparkly** — The sun can make the water sparkle like glitter. Example: "The water looks sparkly in the sun."
5. **Salty** — Ocean water tastes salty (don't drink it!). Example: "The water is salty."
6. **Deep** — Some parts go far down below the surface. Example: "The ocean is very deep."
7. **Peaceful** — Sometimes the ocean is calm and quiet. Example: "The ocean is peaceful in the morning."

Try this quick activity:

1. Pick one adjective from the list.
2. Say a sentence about the ocean using that word (like the examples).
3. You can draw a picture of the ocean showing your word — for example, draw sparkly water or big waves!
