

Claw Clips – Fun Hair for a 4-Year-Old!

Claw clips are little hair clips that look like tiny claws. They hold hair gently and come in many colors and shapes. They are great for making pretty, simple styles.

What we need

- One or two small/medium claw clips (no small loose parts)
- A grown-up to help
- A brush or comb

Easy styles (with grown-up help)

1. **Half-up clip:** Brush hair. Gather the top hair from the temples to the crown. Clip it with a claw clip at the back. Cute and quick!
2. **Tiny bun with clip:** Make a small ponytail at the top or back, twist into a little bun, and secure it with a claw clip over the bun.
3. **Side twist:** Take a small piece of hair from one side, twist it toward the back, and clip it with a colorful claw clip above the ear.
4. **Playful peek-a-boo:** Clip a small colorful claw on one side near the face for a sparkle when your child giggles.

Style tips

- Pick bright colors or fun shapes your child likes (flowers, hearts, animal shapes).
- Match the clip to an outfit or to favorite toys for extra fun.
- Keep clips small and smooth so they are comfy to wear.

Safety and comfort

- Always have a grown-up put in and take out the clip.
- Never put clips in the mouth – they are not toys to chew on.
- Check clips for sharp edges or loose pieces before use.
- If hair gets caught or it pulls, stop and ask the grown-up to remove it carefully.

Make it playful!

Sing a little song while you clip, or let your child pick the color. Hair time can be a happy, cozy moment.

Remember: A grown-up should always help with claw clips for little kids to keep hair safe and comfy.
