

Why do people use claw clips?

How they help (easy words)

- They hold hair so it does not fall in front of the face.
- They are quick to put in â€™ it only takes a little bit of time.

Step-by-step: how someone puts one in

1. Gather the hair in your hand like a little ponytail.
2. Open the claw clip (like opening a little mouth).
3. Put the hair inside and let the clip close around it.
4. Make sure it feels comfy and does not pull on the scalp.

Simple safety tips

- Ask a grown-up to help the first few times.
- Donâ€™t pull hard â€™ that can hurt the head.
- Keep clips away from babies and small children when not being used.
