

Hi! Let's look at these three emojis: 🤯 🤡 🤔

Emojis are like little pictures people use to show feelings. Here's what each one usually means, in easy words:

1. 🤯 (**bomb**) — This can mean something surprising or “explosive” (like big news). Sometimes people use it to be dramatic. But if someone uses it to threaten or say they will hurt someone, that is serious and you should tell an adult.
2. 🤡 (**anger cloud**) — This is a sign someone is angry, frustrated, or upset.
3. 🤔 (**crying cat**) — This shows sadness or that the person is upset and maybe crying.

What the three together might mean

If someone sends 🤯🤡🤔 all at once, they might be saying they are really surprised and angry and also sad about something. But emojis can be confusing — different people use them in different ways.

What you can do — 5 simple steps

1. **Pause.** Don't worry right away — take a breath.
2. **Ask kindly.** Send a caring message like, “Are you okay? What happened?”
3. **Use kind words or emoji.** You can reply with a calm message or something friendly like 🤔❤️ to show you care.
4. **Tell an adult if you're worried.** If the person seems like they might get hurt or might hurt someone else, tell a parent, teacher, or another trusted adult right away.
5. **Don't try to handle big problems alone.** It's always okay to get help from an adult.

Remember: emojis are clues, not always the whole message. Asking a simple question and getting help from an adult when you're worried are the best things to do.
