

An accordion is a fun musical instrument that makes sound when you play it! One of the special parts of an accordion is called the **bellows**. Bellows are like the 'big lungs' of the accordion.

Think of bellows as a folded piece of paper. When you pull it apart, like stretching your arms wide, it gets bigger and lets air in. When you push it back together, it gets smaller and pushes the air out. In an accordion, this pushing and pulling makes air go through the instrument, which helps create music!

So, whenever you see music coming from an accordion, remember that the bellows are working hard, just like how your lungs help you breathe!
