

Modal verbs are auxiliary verbs that express necessity, possibility, permission, or ability. Here are examples of sentences with modal verbs clearly indicated:

- **She *can* swim very well.** (Here, 'can' expresses ability.)
- **You *must* finish your homework before playing.** (In this case, 'must' indicates obligation.)
- **He *might* come to the party later.** ('Might' is used here to express possibility.)
- **We *should* leave early to avoid traffic.** (Here, 'should' suggests advice.)
