Okay, little buddy! Imagine you have a big picture, like a sunny park with trees, grass, and children playing. Sometimes, we get pieces of that picture—like just the tree, or just the kids—those are what we call 'fragments'!

So, when someone asks, 'Which fragments are from the picture?', they want to know which pieces belong to the big sunny park picture. If I give you a piece that shows only the tree and another piece that shows the grass, then both of those are fragments from the main picture!

It's like a jigsaw puzzle—we look for the small pieces that come together to make the whole image!
