

Understanding 'Have', 'Haven't', 'Has', and 'Hasn't'

Hi there! Today we're going to learn about some important words in English: **have**, **haven't**, **has**, and **hasn't**. These words are used to talk about what people own or what they do.

1. What is 'Have'?

We use **have** when we're talking about ourselves or when we're talking about more than one person. For example:

- I **have** a pet dog.
- They **have** a big house.

2. What is 'Haven't'?

Haven't means
