

A helipad is a special place for helicopters to land and take off. Just like how we have playgrounds with swings and slides, helicopters need their own space too!

Sometimes, helipads have special marks or designs on them. These marks are important because they help the pilots know exactly where to land their helicopter. Think about it like a treasure map! If the map shows an 'X', that is where the treasure is hidden. Similarly, the marks on the helipad show pilots where to touch down safely.

These special marks can be things like big letters or shapes. For example, you might see a big 'H' for helicopter. This tells the pilot that this is a helipad! Other marks can help show the direction of the landing or if it's safe to land there. Just like how we follow arrows to find the right path at a park, pilots follow these marks to land safely.

So, the next time you see a helicopter landing, remember those special marks on the helipad help the pilots know just where to go!
