

How to Break a Simple Code

- O=15
- P=16
- Q=17
- R=18
- S=19
- T=20
- U=21
- V=22
- W=23
- X=24
- Y=25
- Z=26

Step 4: Change the Numbers Back to Letters

Now take the coded message and change each letter back into numbers using your key. For instance,

â€ˆDOLPHINâ€ˆ™ would become â€ˆ4-15-12-16-8-9-14â€ˆ™.

Step 5: Try Different Codes

You can also try other ways to code messages, like moving letters forward or backward in the alphabet. For example, if you move each letter one step backward, â€ˆHELLOâ€ˆ™ would become â€ˆGDKKNâ€ˆ™.

Step 6: Practice Makes Perfect!

Keep practicing by creating your own codes and trying to break them. The more you practice, the better you will become at figuring out secret messages!
