

# What's Inside a Plum?

Have you ever tried to eat a plum? They are juicy and delicious! But did you know that inside a plum, there is something very hard? Let's find out!

## Step 1: Look at the Outside

First, when you see a plum, it looks smooth and soft. It can be purple, red, or yellow. This soft skin keeps the juicy part inside safe!

## Step 2: What is Inside?

When you bite into a plum, you first taste the sweet, juicy part called the **flesh**. It's soft and yummy! But if you keep eating, you'll reach a hard part in the middle.

## Step 3: The Hard Part

This hard part is called the **pit** or **stone**. It is very hard and usually brown or gray. The pit protects the seed inside it.

## Step 4: What Happens with the Pit?

The pit is important because inside that pit, there is a seed. If you plant that seed in the ground, it can grow into a new plum tree! Isn't that amazing?
