

Understanding Groups of 6

Hi there! Today, we're going to learn about groups of 6. Let's make it easy and fun!

What Does 'Groups of 6' Mean?

When we talk about 'groups of 6', we're saying we have several sets, and each set has 6 things in it. Think of it like this:

- If you had 6 apples, that's one group of 6 apples.
- If you had another 6 oranges, that's another group of 6 oranges.
- And if you had yet another 6 bananas, that's a third group of 6 bananas.

Let's See How Many We Have!

If we have 3 groups of 6, it means we will add up 6 apples, 6 oranges, and 6 bananas!

So, let's do the math:

1. Group 1: 6
2. Group 2: 6
3. Group 3: 6

Now, we add them together:

- $6 + 6 + 6 = 18$

So, How Many in Total?

We have a total of 18 items when we put together 3 groups of 6! Isn't that cool?
