

# What is 0.6 of 20?

To find out what 0.6 of 20 is, we can follow a few easy steps. Let's do it together!

1. **Understand what 0.6 means:** 0.6 is a decimal number. It can also be written as a fraction. 0.6 is the same as **6/10** or **3/5**. This means that if we have something divided into 5 equal parts, taking 3 parts will give us 0.6.
2. **Next step: Multiply!** To find 0.6 of 20, we can multiply 20 by 0.6. So we do:  **$20 \times 0.6$** .
3. **Doing the multiplication:** First, we can break it down a bit. We can think of 0.6 as **6/10**. So we need to find out  **$20 \times 6/10$** . When we multiply 20 by 6, we get 120.
4. **Now, divide by 10:** We have 120, and now we divide that by 10. So  **$120 \div 10 = 12$** .

So, **0.6 of 20 is 12!** This means if you have 20 candies, and you take 0.6 of that amount, you will have 12 candies. It's like gathering 3 parts out of the 5 equal parts of 20!
