

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand and apply division concepts using Minecraft.

Materials and Prep

- A computer or tablet with Minecraft installed
- A notebook or paper for taking notes
- Prior knowledge of basic division concepts

Activities

- Activity 1: Minecraft Division Challenge

In Minecraft, create a scenario where you have a certain number of blocks and you want to divide them equally among a group of friends. Calculate how many blocks each friend will receive and build the division problem in Minecraft.

- Activity 2: Division Word Problems

Create division word problems related to Minecraft. For example, "Steve has 24 diamonds and wants to share them equally among his 3 friends. How many diamonds will each friend receive?" Solve the word problems and write down the division equations.

- Activity 3: Division Tower Building

In Minecraft, build a tower using blocks of different colors. Divide the tower into equal sections and count how many blocks are in each section. Write down the division equation that represents the division of the tower.

Talking Points

- Division is a way of sharing or distributing things equally among a group.
- When we divide, we are looking for the number of groups or how many items each group will have.
- In Minecraft, we can create scenarios where we need to divide resources or objects among characters or friends.
- When we divide, we can use the division symbol \div or write the division equation using a division bar.
- To solve a division problem, we need to know the total number of items or resources and the number of groups or friends we want to divide them among.
- Division can also be represented using repeated subtraction or by finding the number of times

a smaller number can be subtracted from a larger number.

- Remember to check your answers by multiplying the quotient (the result of division) by the divisor (the number of groups) to see if it equals the dividend (the total number of items).
- Practicing division in Minecraft can help us understand and apply division concepts in real-life situations.
- Have fun exploring division in Minecraft and see how it can be useful in different scenarios!
