Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to introduce themselves in Urdu, understand basic greetings, and engage in simple conversations.

Materials and Prep

- Urdu language textbook or online resources
- Pen and paper
- Access to audio recordings or videos for pronunciation practice

No prior knowledge of Urdu is required.

Activities

- Listen and Repeat: Play audio recordings of common Urdu phrases and have the student listen and repeat after each phrase. Focus on pronunciation and intonation.
- Flashcards: Create flashcards with Urdu vocabulary words and their English translations. Practice matching the words and their meanings.
