

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to:

- Create a piece of artwork inspired by Warrior Cats
- Write a short story or poem about Warrior Cats
- Understand the historical and cultural significance of cats in different societies
- Participate in physical activities that mimic the agility and strength of cats
- Explore scientific facts about cats and their behaviors

Materials and Prep

- Art supplies (paper, pencils, markers, etc.)
- Writing materials (paper, pens, etc.)
- Access to books or online resources about the history of cats
- Space for physical activities
- Access to books or online resources about cat behavior and biology

Activities
