

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to analyze and comprehend a reading passage about horses, identify key details, and make connections to their own experiences.

Materials and Prep

- Reading passage about horses
- Pen or pencil
- Notebook or paper

No additional preparation is required for this lesson.

Activities

1. Read the passage about horses aloud together.
2. Discuss the main ideas and key details from the passage.
3. Ask the student to write a short summary of what they learned from the passage in their notebook or on a piece of paper.
4. Encourage the student to make connections between the information in the passage and their own experiences with horses or other animals.
5. Have the student share their summary and connections with you or another family member.
