

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to:

- Use English skills to describe and write about Barbie dolls
- Practice basic Math concepts through counting, sorting, and measuring Barbie accessories
- Explore Science concepts related to materials and properties by examining different Barbie doll clothing

Materials and Prep

- Barbie dolls and accessories
- Paper and crayons/markers
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Various Barbie doll clothing items

No specific prior knowledge is required.

Activities

1. English Activity: Ask the student to describe their favorite Barbie doll. Have them draw a picture of the doll and write a short paragraph describing its appearance and personality.
2. Math Activity: Sort the Barbie accessories into different categories (e.g., shoes, hats, purses). Count how many items are in each category and write the numbers down. Then, ask the student to find the total number of accessories they have.
3. Science Activity: Examine different Barbie doll clothing items made of various materials (e.g., fabric, plastic). Discuss the properties of each material, such as softness, flexibility, and durability. Encourage the student to touch and feel the clothing to compare the materials.

Talking Points

- "Today, we are going to learn about Barbie dolls and have fun with English, Math, and Science activities."
- "Let's start by using our English skills to describe our favorite Barbie doll. We will draw a picture and write a paragraph about it."
- "Now, let's move on to Math. We will sort the Barbie accessories into different categories and count how many items are in each category. Then, we will find the total number of accessories we have."
- "For our Science activity, we will examine different Barbie doll clothing items. We will talk about the materials they are made of and how they feel. We can compare the softness, flexibility, and durability of the clothing."
- "Remember, it's important to use our words to describe things and to count carefully in Math. In Science, we will explore different materials and their properties."
- "Great job today! You used your English, Math, and Science skills while having fun with Barbie dolls. Keep up the good work!"
