

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to learn about Nesa and have fun exploring different activities related to it.

## Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Tape
- Internet access (optional)

Before starting the lesson, make sure you have a basic understanding of shapes and colors.

## Activities

1. Draw and Color Nesa: Use your crayons or colored pencils to draw and color your own Nesa. Be creative and give it a unique look!
2. Cut and Assemble Nesa Puzzle: Cut out the Nesa shape you drew in the previous activity into several puzzle pieces. Mix them up and try to put them back together like a puzzle.
3. Nesa Scavenger Hunt: Look around your house or outside for objects that resemble the shape of Nesa. Collect them and create a Nesa-themed display.
4. Nesa Shapes Collage: Cut out different shapes from colored paper or magazines. Arrange and glue them onto a larger piece of paper to create a Nesa-inspired collage.
5. Online Nesa Exploration: If you have internet access, search for images of Nesa online. Look at different representations and variations of Nesa and discuss what you like about them.

## Talking Points

- "Nesa is a special shape that we can create and have fun with!"
- "Let's draw and color our own Nesa using crayons or colored pencils."
- "Now, let's cut out the Nesa shape we just drew and make a puzzle out of it. Can you put the pieces back together?"
- "We can find objects around us that look like Nesa. Let's go on a scavenger hunt and collect them."
- "Using different shapes, we can create a beautiful collage inspired by Nesa. Let's cut out shapes and glue them onto a bigger piece of paper."
- "If we have internet access, we can search for pictures of Nesa online. Let's explore and see how many different variations we can find."
