Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will understand the historical context of the Viking era and its influence on Minecraft.

Materials and Prep

- Computer or tablet with Minecraft installed
- Pen and paper
- Access to the internet for research

Prior knowledge of Minecraft gameplay is helpful but not necessary.

Activities

- 1. Research Viking history and culture online. Take notes on their way of life, exploration, and achievements.
- 2. Log in to Minecraft and create a Viking-inspired world. Build a village, longhouses, and ships using blocks available in the game.
- 3. Role-play as a Viking character in Minecraft. Explore your created world, interact with villagers, and simulate Viking adventures.
- 4. Write a short story or create a comic strip about a Viking journey using both historical facts and elements from your Minecraft world.

Talking Points

- **The Vikings:** "The Vikings were seafaring Norse people from the late 8th to early 11th centuries. They were known for their exploration, trade, and raiding activities."
- Viking Society: "Viking society was organized into classes, with jarls (nobles) at the top, followed by karls (freemen), and thralls (slaves). They had a strong warrior culture and valued bravery in battle."
- **Viking Longships:** "Viking longships were fast and versatile vessels used for both transportation and warfare. They were designed to navigate rivers, shallow waters, and the open sea."
- Viking Exploration: "The Vikings were skilled navigators who explored and settled in various parts of Europe, Asia, and even North America. They established trade routes and founded new settlements."
- Viking Influence on Minecraft: "Minecraft, a popular sandbox game, draws inspiration from Viking culture. You can find Viking-themed blocks, items, and structures in the game, allowing players to recreate their own Viking adventures."
